About Us

Learn to Skate Dayton offers a variety of programming. Classes for all ages and abilities are offered in recreational and competitive skating. We use the Skate with US program designed by the United States Figure Skating to aid in learning and skating enjoyment. Come join the fun!!

What's Included with the fee for LTS?

- ◆ This is a 7 week session
- ◆ Each skater may stay after class for 30 minutes to practice their skills. Classes finishing at 4:20 on Sunday will practice before their lesson.
- ◆ Class sizes are 3-6 students per instructor for Snowplow Sam classes; 5-12 students per instructor for Basic 1-Freeskate 6.
- ◆ Skaters are tested during the last class to determine skill mastery and progression to the next level. Certificates are awarded to all skaters. Patches will be given to all skaters who pass their skating level.
- ◆ If you refer a new skater to our program you will receive a pass for 4 free public skates.

Cost—7 week class

- * Cost for 25 minute LTS classes is \$100
- * Cost for 50 minute classes \$130
- * Cost for 4 week Girl/Boy Scout Class \$30
- * Skate Rental \$1 per week to be paid to South Metro
- ◆ Sign up for classes at the registration table in front of the ice rink on registration dates/times for a \$10 discount. You can also register for classes on line on the dates listed for a \$10 discount.
- ◆ You can register on line - www.learntoskatedayton.com at any time.
- ◆ Registrations will be accepted the first day of class based on availability. Registrations will be taken through the second week of the session based on availability. Classes will not be pro-rated.
- ◆ New skaters will receive a US Figure Skating Booklet to track their skills and aid in the practice time on the first day of class.
- ◆ Classes may close before the first day of class.
- ◆ On the first day of class arrive 20 minutes early to pick up name tag and try skates on before meeting coach at the sign with your name and level.



Policies / Discounts

- ◆ **Registration:** A \$10 discount is given only if you register during one of our registration times with the LTS Dayton staff or special on-line dates (see front of brochure). Classes close after the second week or when full.
 - ◆ **Penalties:** A \$30 fee is assessed on all returned checks.
 - ◆ **Refunds:** 100% before registration deadline, 75% after the first week 50% after the second week of classes. No refund after third class. No refund for USFS membership at any time.
 - ◆ **Class Cancellations/Confirmations:** We reserve the right to cancel an individual class because of a rink conflict. In such a case, a make-up class will be scheduled. No confirmation calls will be made or letters sent. For on-line registrations your credit card confirmation is a class confirmation.
 - ◆ **Make-ups**—There are no make-up classes
 - ◆ **Class Size:** In order to hold a class, there must be a minimum of 3 skaters. If this minimum is not met, we have the right to combine levels or cancel the class.

- From the West: • I-70 East to I-75 South to I-675 North. • Take I-675 North to Exit 2 (Miamisburg/Centerville); turn right onto Rt-725. • Proceed to Yankee St. and turn right. • Take Yankee St. to Austin Pike (Yankee Trace Golf Club will be on the left) and turn right. • Proceed approx. 500 yards and turn left on Success Lane. • Arena is on the right.

Learn to Skate

We offer Learn to Skate classes for kids starting at age 3 through adults. The beginning classes for age 3-5 is called Snowplow Sam 1, ages 6-14 called Basic 1, and 14 and up is Adult 1. These classes are 25 minutes in length. Once the skaters reach Basic 3 or Hockey 1 classes move to 50 minutes in length. See our web site of the current session insert or on-line for specific skills at each level and time and day offerings. We offer classes thru Free Skating (jumps & spins).

Tiny Tots & Home School

Our Wednesday at 10:30 am and 1:30pm we are geared toward Home School skaters and kids ages 3-6yrs old. If a Mother's/Father's group have enough members to have their own class we may also be able to schedule an alternative day for our just for your group. Home School—We would love to help you fill your physical education requirement in a fun and unique way. If a home school association would like to have an outing, lessons, party etc.. Groups

Group events are always welcome. From school PTA skate nights, church groups, school field days to company parties. We would be happy to arrange ice time, a lesson, and accommodate your group in any way that we can.

Private Lessons

Private and semi-private lessons can be added to group lessons at any time. They are great to help a skater who would like to move along a bit faster, would like to compete or just needs some extra one on one attention. Coaching rates range From \$8 to \$15 for a 15 minute lesson, plus the cost of ice. Please call Denise Mackey at 513-759-4259 or talk to your group lesson instructor for more information or to schedule a lesson. Lessons are taught after school on Thursday's and on Public Sessions at South Metro. They are also available in Cincinnati M-W and Fri. at Sports Plus.

Girl / Boy Scouts

We have created a program where Girl / Boy Scouts and Brownies / Cubs are able to learn new skills, learn about the sport of figure skating or ice hockey and complete a portion of their Sports Badge. This class can begin any week and run for 4 weeks for \$30 per skater. Space is limited so call or e-mail to reserve a slot. A one day class can also be arranged—\$10 per skater (25 minute lesson, 25 minute free skate).

Format of Lessons

- ◆ 4 week session (Sunday between 2:30-3:30 PM or select Monday or Thursday afternoons)
- ◆ 25 minute of skating lesson each class
- ◆ Troop must have 10 skaters to hold a class
- ◆ Brothers and sisters may take the class with the Scouts at the same time.
